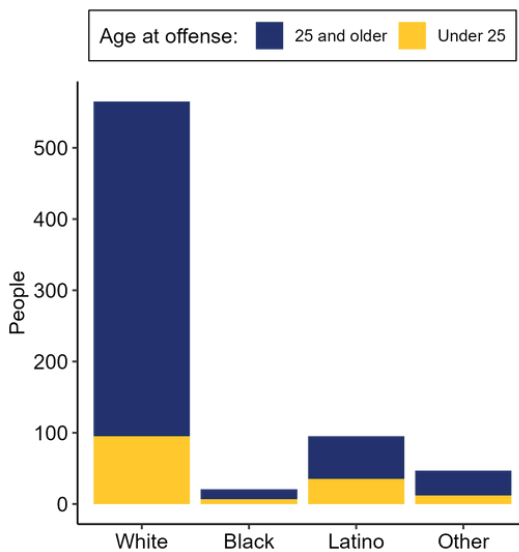
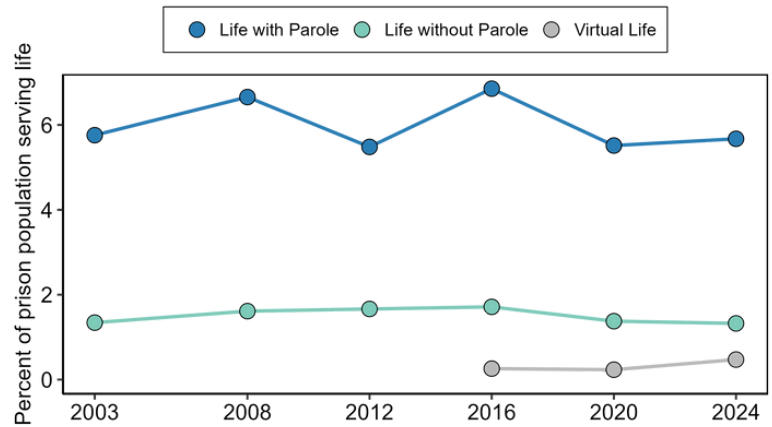
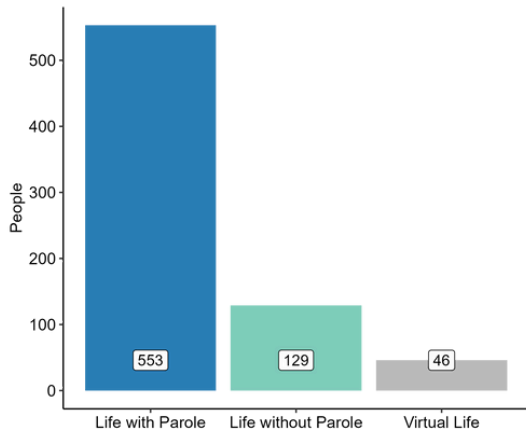


Life Imprisonment in Idaho

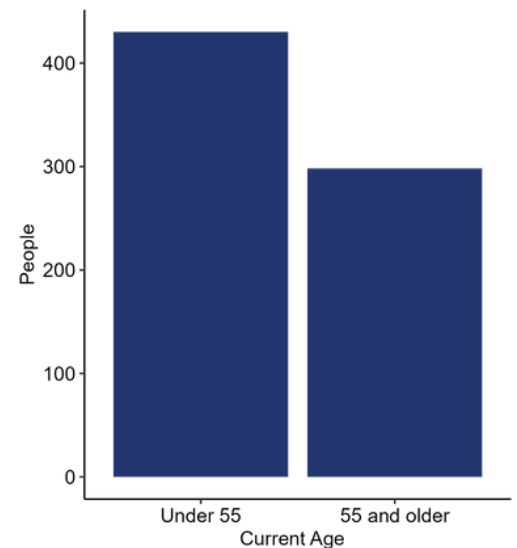


As of 2024, there were **728** people in Idaho serving a life sentence, **7%** of the total prison population. This makes Idaho the **43rd** highest ranked state by proportion of incarcerated people serving life sentences.



People of color make up **18%** of the population in Idaho and **22%** of people serving life sentences. **33%** of Black people and **37%** of Latinos serving life sentences were **under the age of 25** at the time of offense.

41% of people serving life are **55 or older**.



*Data Note: Virtual Life is defined as a sentence of 50 years or more and this data was first collected in 2016
