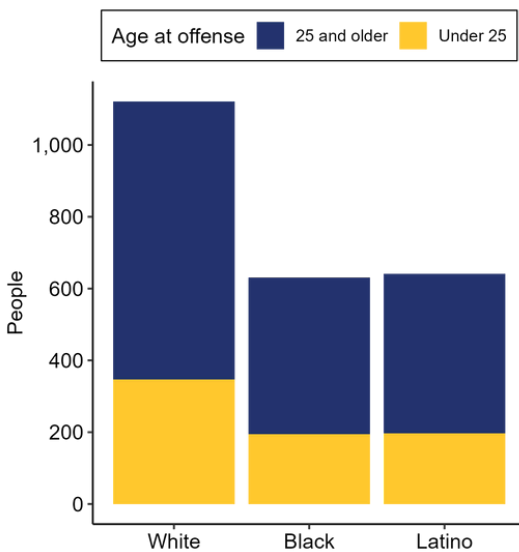
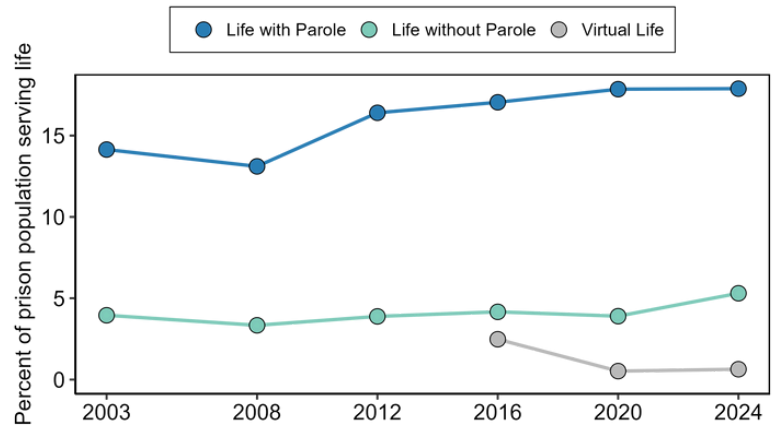
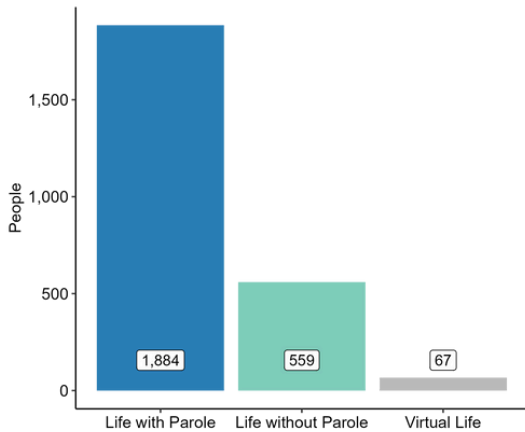


Life Imprisonment in Nevada

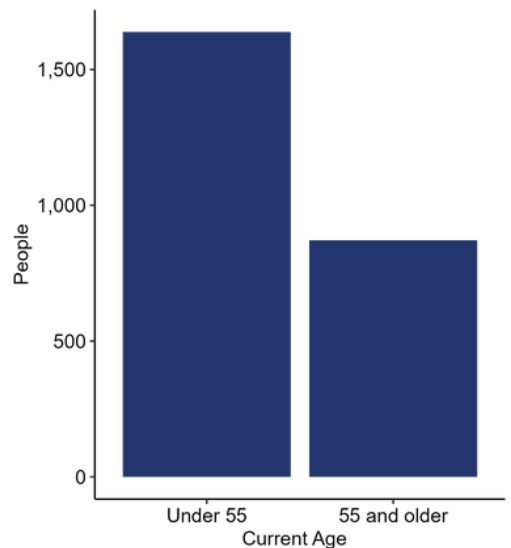


As of 2024, there were **2,510** people in Nevada serving a life sentence, **24%** of the total prison population. This makes Nevada the **5th** highest ranked state by proportion of incarcerated people serving life sentences.



People of color make up **49%** of the population in Nevada and **55%** of people serving life sentences. **31%** of Black people and **31%** of Latinos serving life sentences were **under the age of 25** at the time of offense.

35% of people serving life are **55 or older**.



*Data Note: Virtual Life is defined as a sentence of 50 years or more. This data was first collected in 2016.
